



# TECHNICAL SHEET VINTAGE 2019

*The 2019 harvest began, with one day to go, like the 2018 harvest, on Wednesday September 25th. It was the eponymous plot (Desmirail) of merlots which made the first move on a slightly cloudy day.*

*The sky, during the harvest, played with the winegrower's nerves, while the vines appreciated the few rains that he was kind enough to grant them.*

*A short stop from October 4th to 8th, before starting the Cabernets, which will also play on the winegrower's nerves. Indeed, they will be picked up until the evening of October 16th. The harvest will be spread over three weeks, 10 days longer than last year.*

*The winegrower's patience was not in vain, as the result was over expectations. With Merlot on the fruit and not very alcoholic (13 degrees on average) and Cabernets in unison, with an average of 12 degrees.*

*In 2019, after two lean years, quantity rhymes with quality. The vintages in 9 have regularly rewarded us with superior quality such as 59, 89 and 2009 for example.*
