

Technical sheet Vintage 2012

Initial de Desmirail, 2nd wine of Château Desmirail, 3rd Grand Cru Classé, is a soft and fruity wine. It has a high proportion of Cabernet Sauvignon, which is a guarantee of good aging. It is aged like its elder brother Château Desmirail in barrels for 10-14 months.

Deep ruby color. The nose is expressive and full of greed with notes of ripe black fruits, blackcurrant, blackberry and black cherry. The mouth is round and structured with melted tannins. The wine has a nice balance. The finish is long and fruity.
