

## Technical sheet Vintage 2019

*The 2019 harvest began, a day after than the 2018 harvest, on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> of September. It was the eponymous plot (Desmirail) of Merlot that opened the dance with a cloudy day.* 

*The harvest was exceptionally long, extending over three weeks instead of two, for most of vintages.* 

The winegrower's patience was not pointless, because the result was as good as his expectations. With Merlot on the fruit and not very alcoholic (13 degrees on average) and Cabernet-Sauvignon in unison, with an average of 12 degrees.

*This year, after 2 years of low volume, quantity rhymes with quality. The vintages in 9 have regularly given us a superior quality like, as an example 1959, 1989 and 2009.*
