

Technical sheet Vintage 2019

The 2019 harvest began, a day after than the 2018 harvest, on Wednesday 25th of September. It was the eponymous plot (Desmirail) of Merlot that opened the dance with a cloudy day.

The harvest was exceptionally long, extending over three weeks instead of two, for most of vintages.

The winegrower's patience was not pointless, because the result was as good as his expectations. With Merlot on the fruit and not very alcoholic (13 degrees on average) and Cabernet-Sauvignon in unison, with an average of 12 degrees.

This year, after 2 years of low volume, quantity rhymes with quality. The vintages in 9 have regularly given us a superior quality like, as an example 1959, 1989 and 2009.
